Community Care Program Asset Guideline 2026

Assets will be considered along with the patient's income to determine eligibility for the Community Care Program for patients above 200% FPL. To be eligible, reportable assets may not exceed \$25,000 for a household of one (1), or \$50,000 for a household of two (2) or more.

Assets may include but are not limited to items such as checking and savings accounts, IRA's, 401K's, Pensions, Health Savings Accounts, additional property, and any other retirement funding.
